Make copies and keep them somewhere safe.

As technology moves forward we take it a step at a time, inch by inch. Sooner than later we walk through those brick walls and share the excitement and discoveries with family. Be your family's historian. You are the storyteller

New Hope Baptist Church, Wetmore, Colorado

Article and transcriptions by Carolyn Thomson

New Hope Baptist Church is located in Wetmore, Colorado.¹ Wetmore is an unincorporated community in Custer County, Colorado located approximately 30 miles west of Pueblo at the junction of State Highway 96 and 67 near Hardscrabble Creek at the edge of the Wet Mountains. The area was also known as Greenwood Park or Hardscrabble Park. On May 13, 1871, a group of settlers organized and built the New Hope Baptist Church.² The initial meeting took place at the school house near Ira Porter's home in Hardscrabble Park. He donated land for the construction of the church; it was completed in 1873. Services continued until 1917 when the new Wetmore Community Church was completed.³ Today, the old church is preserved as a local landmark.



A microfilm entitled “New Hope Baptist Church – Wetmore, Colorado – 1871-1876, 1913-1926” is part of the Denver Public Library’s manuscript collection.⁴ The film covers two books: *A Record of the Baptist Church called New Hope (1871-1876)* and *Church Roll – alphabetically arranged – and Record Book (1913-1926)*. There are also miscellaneous additional papers on the film.

The initial project was to transcribe the names of members. However, a review of the film found that the sections identified as Members was incomplete; the Meeting minutes contained numerous additional names of members or attendees. Thus the project was expanded and the results are split into three parts: Names from 1871-1876 book, Names from Business of Regular Minutes from 1871-1876 book, and Names from 1913-1926 book.

The Wetmore-Hardscrabble Genealogical and Historical Society was contacted for help in confirming the spelling of the names. They passed the request onto Peggy Martin who is the caretaker of the New Hope Baptist Church Cemetery and Church. Her family has lived in Wetmore for several generations and thus she was able to provide additional information from her research and records. This information has been included.

A Record of the Baptist Church called New Hope (1871-1876)

The inside cover of this book says it is “Property of Rev, C. T. Floyd, Cass, Missouri.” His name does not appear again in the book. The INDEX to the book lists the contents to be:

Printed Matters

Linda Wommack. *Colorado's Historic Churches*. The History Press, Charleston, SC. 2019.

Church records can be a gold mine for the genealogist. We often use them to learn the name of a bride or groom or maybe a child's date of birth, names of parents, and other family members or friends. They can also provide a family's location, and of course, give you a strong indication of your ancestor's religion. If you're lucky, you may have photographs of a wedding or christening outside of the church, family members smiling. But what if you don't? Have you ever tried to imagine what the church looked like? Was it a small country church or something grander in the city? *Colorado's Historic Churches* is a resource that can help you visualize just how that church looked. Covering locations in all parts of the state, and including all denominations, Wommack tells the colorful histories of early Colorado with a unique perspective.

Some churches used well-known architects to design their buildings, while others used "the local talent." Cornish miners were often used as stonemasons by mountain congregations. While most of the churches in mining communities were simple, some of their city cousins could be quite lavish. But no matter where they were located, many churches imported items from Europe. In 1898 the Catholic Church in Silver Plume brought hand-carved double wooden doors from Italy for their new addition, the sanctuary of St. John's Episcopal Cathedral has several pieces of hand-carved Salonica oak, and lots of Colorado's church bells and stained glass are from Europe.

The book's index lists the names of the churches, but no people or locations are included. There is a notes section and a bibliography. Among the interesting facts in Wommack's book:

While the Central Presbyterian Church in Denver was being built, the congregation held services in the Broadway Theater. Liking the warmth of the many fireplaces and the comfortable seating, the new sanctuary was built to resemble an opera house with a sloped floor, cushioned seats and strategically placed fireplaces.

In 1899 the Methodist Episcopal Church in Central City installed a rare Steere & Sons pipe organ which, until 1932, was powered by water. Georgetown's Grace Episcopal Church has a rare Johnson pump organ in a solid oak casing that is believed to be the oldest operating pipe organ in the state. The First Presbyterian Church in Monte Vista used small boys hidden behind a screen to pump their organ.

The bell used for the Methodist Church in Breckenridge caused many problems. Although Father Dyer had received permission from the city to use the firemen's bell on Sundays, the confusion for the volunteer fireman as to whether they were answering a fire call or a church service forced the fire station to move down the hill. A few years later, and with the arrival of a new pastor, Florida Passmore, the congregation had sufficient funds to build a belfry for their own bell. But raising funds for the church was not the only passion of Reverend Passmore. He relentlessly campaigned against saloons and helped pass a state law which required saloons to close at midnight and remained closed on Sundays. An unfortunate turn of events for the miners around Breckenridge, they held Reverend Passmore responsible. The belfry of the church was dynamited the night of August 17, 1891.

Handy Church in Grand Junction was a significant force for the black community and continues to this day to have descendants of the original congregation at its helm. In 1920 they built Chapel House which was used as a way station by black travelers. Erected in 1889, Temple Aaron in Trinidad is considered to be the oldest synagogue in the Rocky Mountain West. The Lake City Baptist Church decided to use folding opera chairs instead of pews. Gambling winnings built the first church in Creede. Susan B. Anthony was the keynote speaker at the dedication of the

Methodist church in Del Norte.

In addition to the information on the church buildings themselves, this book can also give you clues to other aspects of a community. Sometimes additional parishes were established in a town to serve a particular ethnic group with a large population. Oftentimes a church would build a school; sometimes it would be a convent, hospital or rest home. Which quarry the stone came from is mentioned and if it provided stone for other buildings. Maybe your ancestor literally helped build a town. A few churches have compiled anniversary journals, and this is also noted. Because most of the historical photos are from the Denver Public Library collection, and all of the entries have their Colorado State Register and/or their National Register of Historic Places registry numbers listed, this book provides a useful guide for any further research you want to pursue.
